



Quick Guide to Responding Promptly to Safeguarding Concerns and Allegations.

You suspect or witness abuse, or someone discloses information about a safeguarding concern or allegation.

Assess – are they in immediate danger or not



YES

Emergency – immediate

If a child or an adult is in immediate danger or requires medical attention, call the police and /or social services immediately on 999.

NO


Discuss next steps with:
Safeguarding Officer for your organisation.

Or the Safeguarding trustee



Record and report to the Safeguarding Trustee.

It is important that information is only shared with those from statutory agencies who need to know, please do not share with anyone else.
